- Fun Adhesive Bandages (Band-Aids)

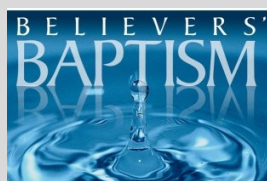

- School Supplies

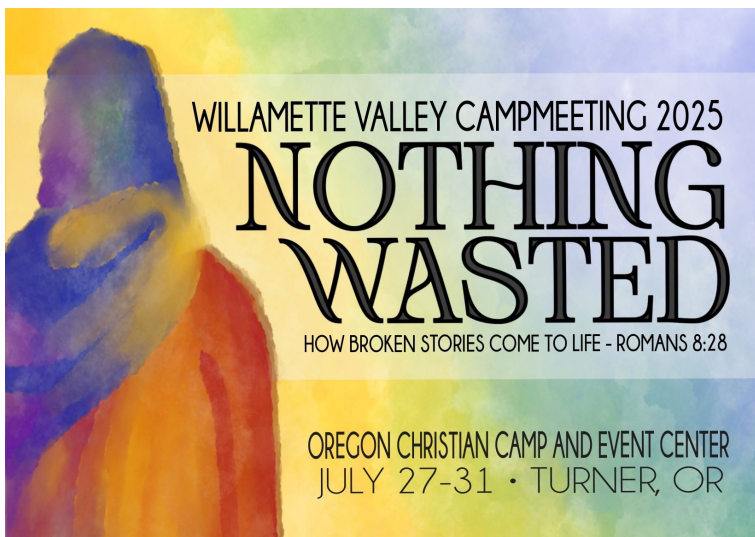
